The church is being asked, on issue after issue, to accommodate itself to a world that has already decided what the Bible should say. This book refuses to go along with that.

Twenty-one chapters. Twenty-one questions the church most often handles evasively — and one method: go back to the text, find out what it actually says, and say that.

From the authority and sufficiency of Scripture to marriage, desire, sexuality, the sanctity of life, Marxism, political violence, antisemitism, the Christian West, and the false gospels dressed as Christianity — *Confronting the World with Biblical Truth* is a Reformed Baptist layman's case for plain dealing with hard questions.

Confidence is only a virtue when it rests on truth. A belief is not an identity. The reader who has confidently held a position for decades has the most reason to bring it carefully back to the text, not the least.

The Bereans examined the Scriptures daily to see whether the things they were being told were true. This book is an invitation to do the same.
